WHY STUDY BACHELOR DEGREE IN LAW

The Bachelor of Law, a degree fully taught and assessed in English, is designed to prepare students for a career in law and in the legal areas of public and private sector organisations. It also opens opportunities for future graduate study. The programme offers a variety of general and specialist modules covering civil law, procedural law, commercial law, criminal law, administrative law, and public international law amongst other legal disciplines. The course is taught by academics from different places around the world, including the UAE and the UK, most of whom have legal practice experience in the private legal sector, in dispute resolution and/or in public authorities.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Secondary level education (12 years) or equivalent.

Curricula taught in English are exempted from English Language requirement.

For Ministry curriculum a grade of 80% for English language in high school or Academic IELTS with an overall score of 5.0 or equivalent is required.

Students must have a grade of 70% in Math and in any other two subjects (excluding Arabic, English and Islamic Studies)

PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

Through a range of different modules, students on the Bachelor of Law (BoL) study substantive law and procedural law, in anticipation of a legal internship, which forms part of their studies. Assessments vary from module to module, but typically include exams as well as coursework, such as essays or other projects, which students work on individually or in pairs. The course content is principally taught from a UAE perspective to prepare students for the local market, however the Bachelor of Law (BoL) also offers students a foundational understanding of English law, especially to the extent applicable in the UAE, as well as international law.

CAREER PROSPECTS

A law graduate can choose to start a career in one of several legal fields. For most of these, additional professional qualifications will be required following the successful completion of the Bachelor of Law Programme. Potential careers include working as lawyers or legal consultants in private companies, governmental or semi-governmental departments or – subject to eligibility - joining the judicial authority to become a judge or public prosecutor. Graduates will also have the opportunity to work towards becoming members of academic and research institutions as legal researchers, or join security agencies, international organisations, or arbitration centres.
